3 Year Work Plan

- Contents: broad program objectives, activities planned and resource requirement over the coming three-year period
- Reviewing: at annual meetings
- **■** Approval: by SSATP Board
- **Responsibility:** Program management in consultation with country coordinators
- **▼ Timing:** at three year intervals updating whenever required

Annual Work Plan

- **Contents:** detailed country and thematic activities detailed quarterly budget coded per activity
- **♯** Reviewing: at annual meetings
- **♯** Approval: by SSATP Board
- **Responsibility:** Program management in consultation with country coordinators
- **★ Timing:** each year during period September to December

Quarterly Progress Report

- ➡ Contents: progress reporting against plan, including expenditure information - explanation of divergence of progress as against plan
- **★ Reviewing:** dissemination to all stakeholders, reflection of comments in the following report
- **♯** Approval: by SSATP Board
- **♯** Responsibility: Country coordinators, compilation and dissemination by program management
- **♯** Timing: months following quarter

Annual Progress Report

- **♯** Contents: summary of annual progress report against plan, including expenditure information explanation of divergence
- **♯** Reviewing: by Annual Assembly
- **Approval**: by SSATP Board
- **♯** Responsibility: Country coordinators, compilation and dissemination by program management
- **Timing:** within first quarter

Proposed Budget Coding

- # Geographical location code
 - e.g. GH for Ghana; RG for regional activity
- **♯** Type of expenditure
 - e.g. CO for country operations; CA for country assistance; TH for thematic work
- **♯** Three digit running numerical
- **♯** For example: GH-CO-001
