

# Activity Sheet 4

## Rural transport linkages

#### **Purpose**


The purpose of this activity is to identify all sectors/issues that link to rural transport, and explore the reasons for these linkages.

### **Group Activity**

- 1. Read the case study sheet provided (pages 3 5).
- 2. Discuss:
  - A. How does rural transport link to other sectors and activities?
  - Focus your discussion on a specific country/ group of countries, drawing on actual examples.
- 3. Draw a diagram with a box "rural transport" in the middle. Connect this to other boxes labelled with all the sectors/activities connected to rural transport
- 4. Below the diagram, briefly list the reasons for the connection of each box with rural transport.
  - Give each box has a reference number. The reasons in the list can then be cross-referenced by this number.
- 5. Prepare your flow diagram on a flip chart using the cards given to you using the broad layout illustrated on the next page. Add additional notes and explanations.
  - Simple example of a flow diagram is illustrated below.

B: reasons 4,5, etc.

C: reason 6 etc.
