

Activity Sheet 47

Mapping of Transport Infrastructure and services

Purpose

The purpose of this activity is to explore transport infrastructure and transport services within a given community and surrounding area. This map should be drawn of a real community/village/area known to the group.

Group Activity

- 1. Draw a map on flip chart showing the transport infrastructure and services for a village and surrounding area, including bridges, roads, paths, jetties and so on, and availability of motorised transport services such as taxis, buses, lorries, boats, animal drawn carts etc.
- 2. Illustrate how the infrastructure and service provision may change between seasons e.g. wet and dry season.
- 3. As a group discuss the following questions:
 - A. Who in the community has <u>access to</u> and <u>uses</u> these transport services and infrastructure?
 - B. How does the use of various transport services differ for different sections of society (men and women, the poor and better off, disadvantaged groups, businesses, traders). Why is this?
 - C. What are the institutions that control the transport networks and infrastructure?
 - D. What is revealed by this sort of participatory technique that might be missed by a simple quantitative survey?
- 4. Prepare to present your findings to the plenary.
