Comparing social benefits and costs of road investments (Uganda)

Case Study #3

Purpose

The purpose of this activity is to deepen participants' knowledge of developing an analytical framework that analyses the social costs and benefits of road investments, focussing on the multi-criteria analysis (MCA) approach piloted in Uganda.

Participants explore how the social benefits and costs from road investment identified by rural communities in Uganda compare with countries, and the advantages and limitations of using the MCA approach in their own country contexts.

Group Activity

- 1. Refer to the copy of the power point handouts, and discuss the following:
 - A. How does the list of benefits and costs from road investment identified by rural communities in Uganda compare with those of rural communities in other countries?
 - B. What would be the advantages and limitations of using the MCA approach in your country context?
- 2. Prepare your notes on flip chart.
- 3. Elect a person to present your findings to the plenary.
