Strengthening Professionalism in the Transport Sector

Report of discussion group debates and recommendations for SSATP

Areas of discussion

- Status of technical and professional capacity in the transport sector.
- Participation of women as transport sector professionals.
- Successes in building capacity e.g. Mt Elgon Training Centre.
- Status and role of professional institutions.
- Effectiveness of international technical assistance.

Areas of Agreement

- Need to strengthen professional institutions to promote professional standards and support sector professionals.
- There should be equal opportunities for men and women in the sector.
- There is a deficit of skills in the sector e.g. materials engineers, transport economists.
- Some countries have not established a cadre of older, experienced professionals and still rely on expats (TA).
- In many cases skills exist, but staff are not given the incentives or the space to act professionally.

Points of Contention

Quotas for women in university and training courses.

Recommendations

- 1. SSATP should introduce capacity development as a core theme for next DP.
- SSATP should support assessments of professional capacity in the sector in collaboration with other organisations.
- 3. SSATP should work with governments and professional associations to promote careers and professionalism in the transport sector, with equal opportunities for men and women (schools, media).
- 4. SSATP should undertake an assessment of the effectiveness and value for money of international technical assistance.
