History of African Road Safety Congress

- First African Road Safety Congress organised in 1984 in Nairobi
- ECA in collaboration with and Nordic countries organised the Congress
- Congress assessed root problems of accident occurrence in Africa
- Congress outcomes:
- ✓ Identification and quantification of road safety problems in Africa
- ✓ Better understanding of road safety situation on the continent

History of African Road Safety Congress (con't)

- Second congress organised in Addis Ababa in 1989
- ECA organised congress during preparatory phase of UNTACDA II (1991-2000)
- Congress organised in collaboration with OECD, various donor agencies and financial institutions
- Strategies and action plans for reversing appalling trend of accidents drawn up

History of African Road Safety Congress (con't)

- Third congress organised in Pretoria in 1997
- Congress organised by ECA, OECD and other partners
- Congress took stock of progress in implementing recommendations of 2nd congress
- Sought further interventions for reducing road accidents in Africa

Context of Conference

- Despite efforts, road safety situation remains alarming
- However, there is renewed commitment to address situation:
- ✓ Reports by UN Secretary General to General Assembly on road safety (2003)
- ✓ 2 UN resolutions on improving global road safety (2004 and 2005)
- ✓ Major publication by WHO and World Bank on road traffic injuries and prevention (2004)
- ✓ First UN Global Road Safety Week in 2007

Objectives of Conference

- Review progress in improving road safety since last congress
- Plan implementation of recommendations of World report on road traffic injury prevention
- Continue preparations for 1st UN Global Road Safety Week
- Advance development of national road safety action plans
- Identify ways of mobilising resources to rapidly improve road safety

Expected Outcome of Conference

- Report of progress in improving road safety between last congress and now
- Development of strategies to advance recommendations of global road safety report
- Plan and timeframe for activities of UN Global Road Safety Week
- Progress and timeframes on national road safety action plans
- Strategies for monitoring road safety targets, and for sharing and applying good practices
- Strategies for financing national action plans

- ✓ Status of road safety in Africa
- ✓ Follow-up activities and funding of road safety programmes
- ✓ Advancing the development of national action plans
- Working Groups (Themes to be finalised)
