CHALLENGE STATEMENT

Many cities in Africa see the benefits of establishing a Transport Authority (TA) to regulate and administer public transportation. This is viewed as fundamental to enabling improved public transport in cities through the integration of all transport functions in one institutional structure at a local sphere of government. However, TA's in African cities have often failed to deliver on this vision, with structural and political factors hindering the successful establishment of TA's.

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While the unique socio-economic or political characteristics of a city may present differentiated challenges to the establishment of a TA, it is possible to identify several pre-requisites for successful TA's that can be replicated in a variety of contexts.

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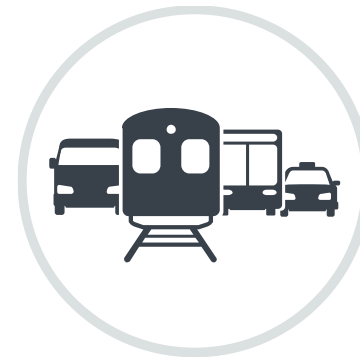
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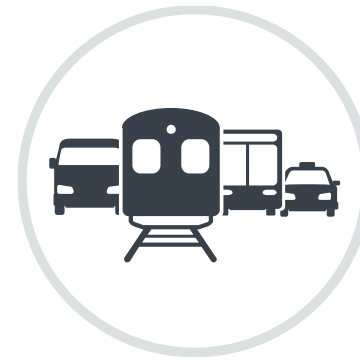
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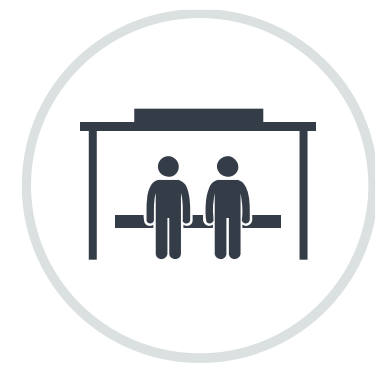
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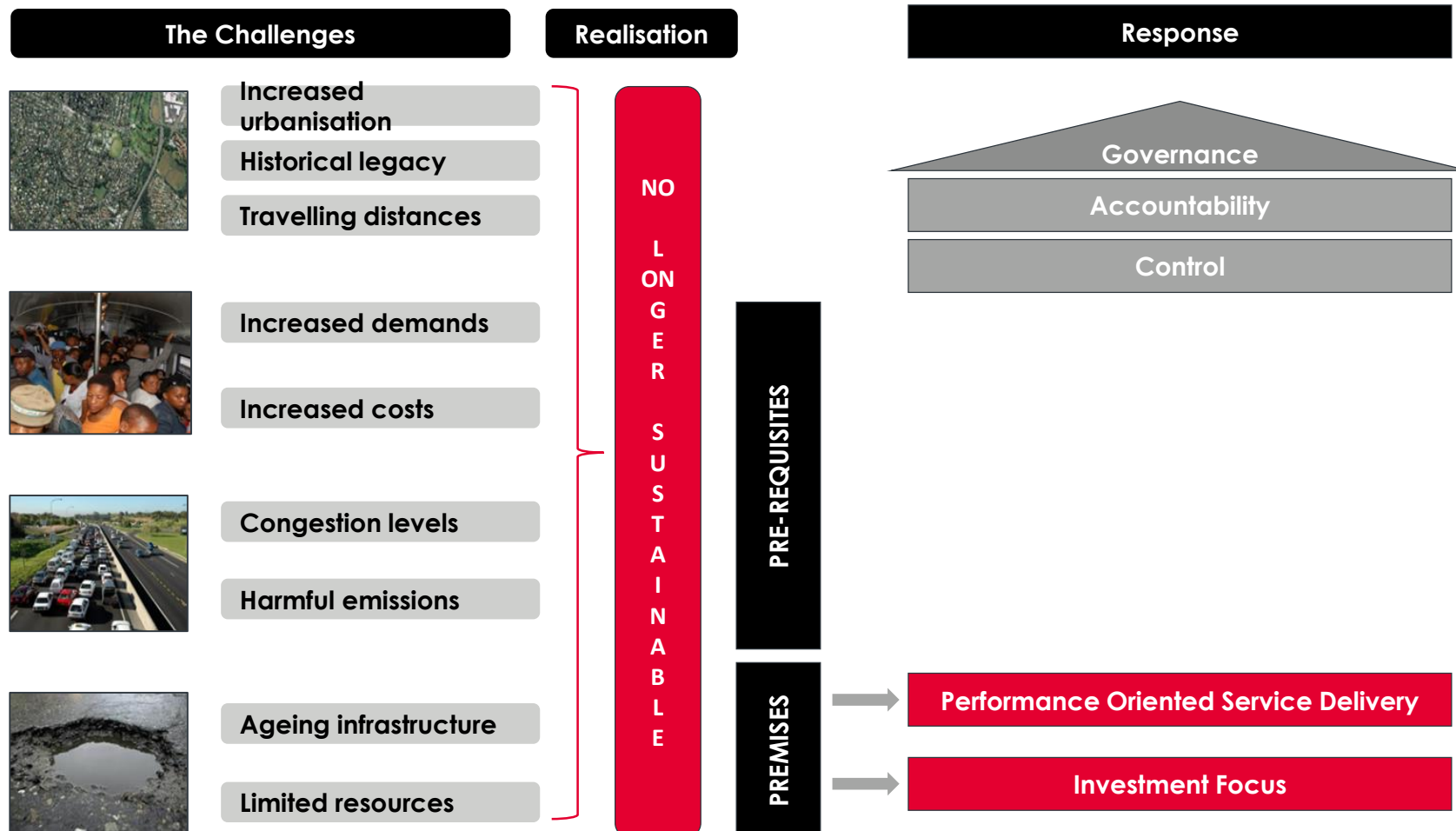


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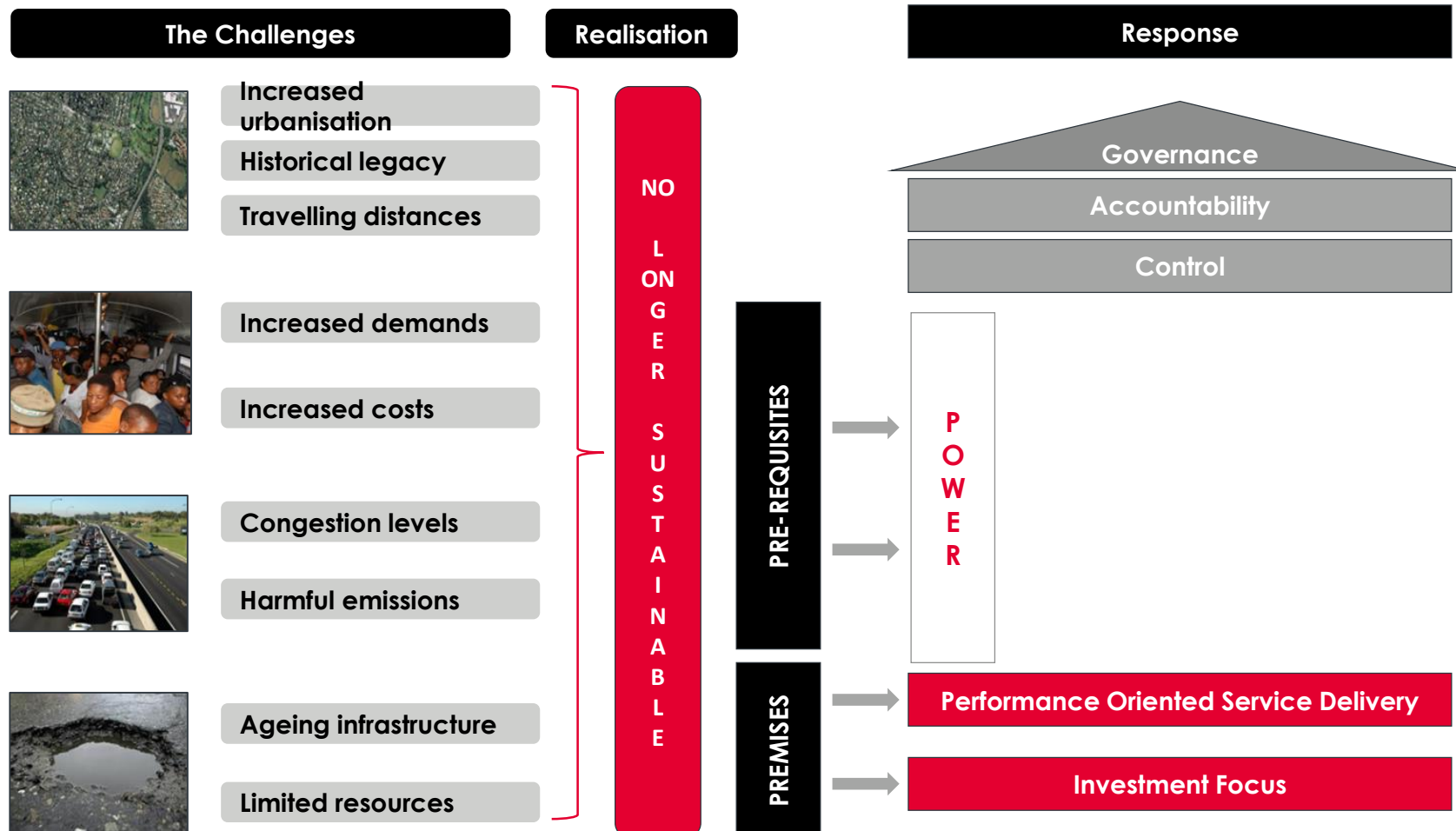


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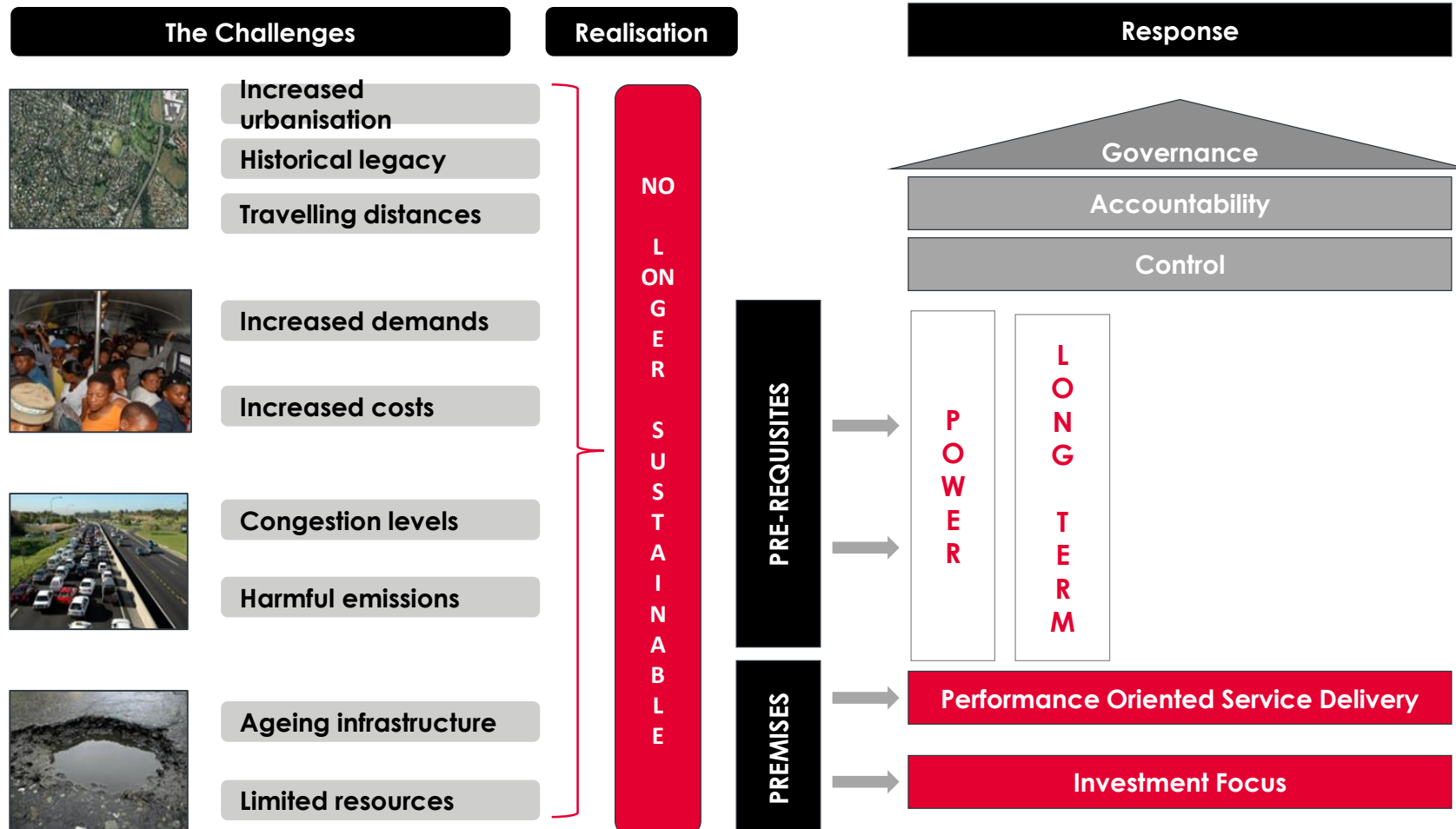
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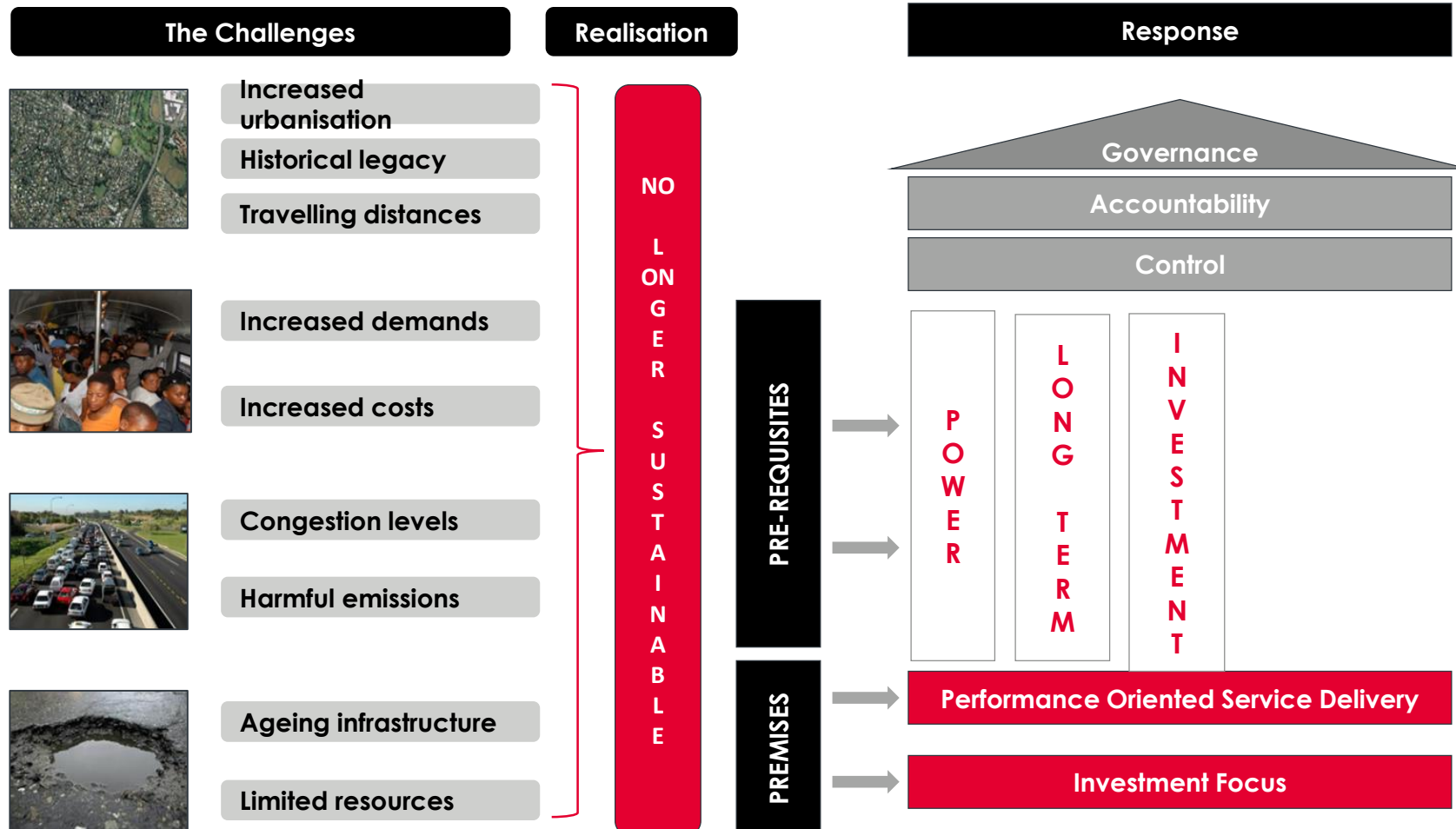
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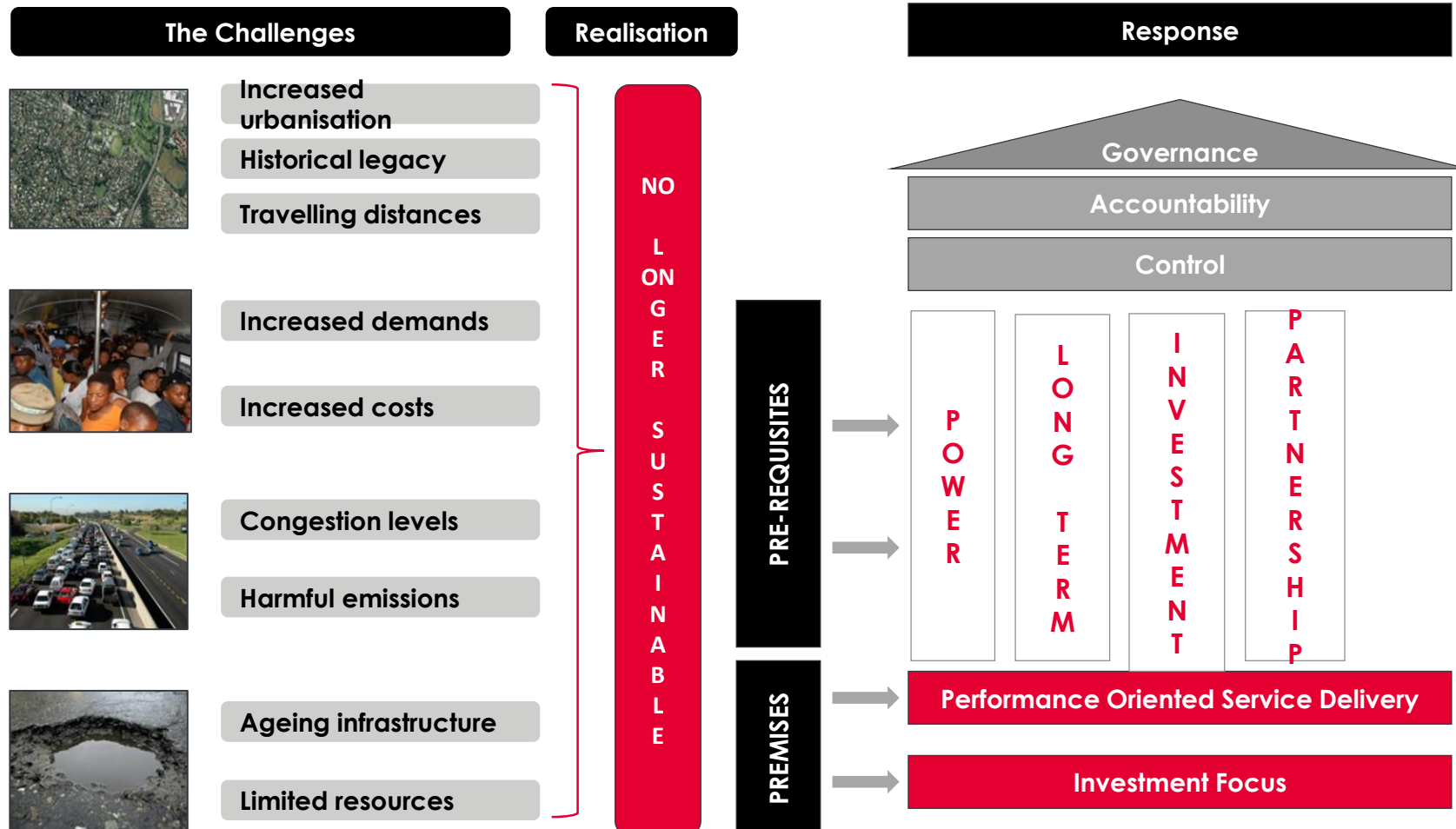
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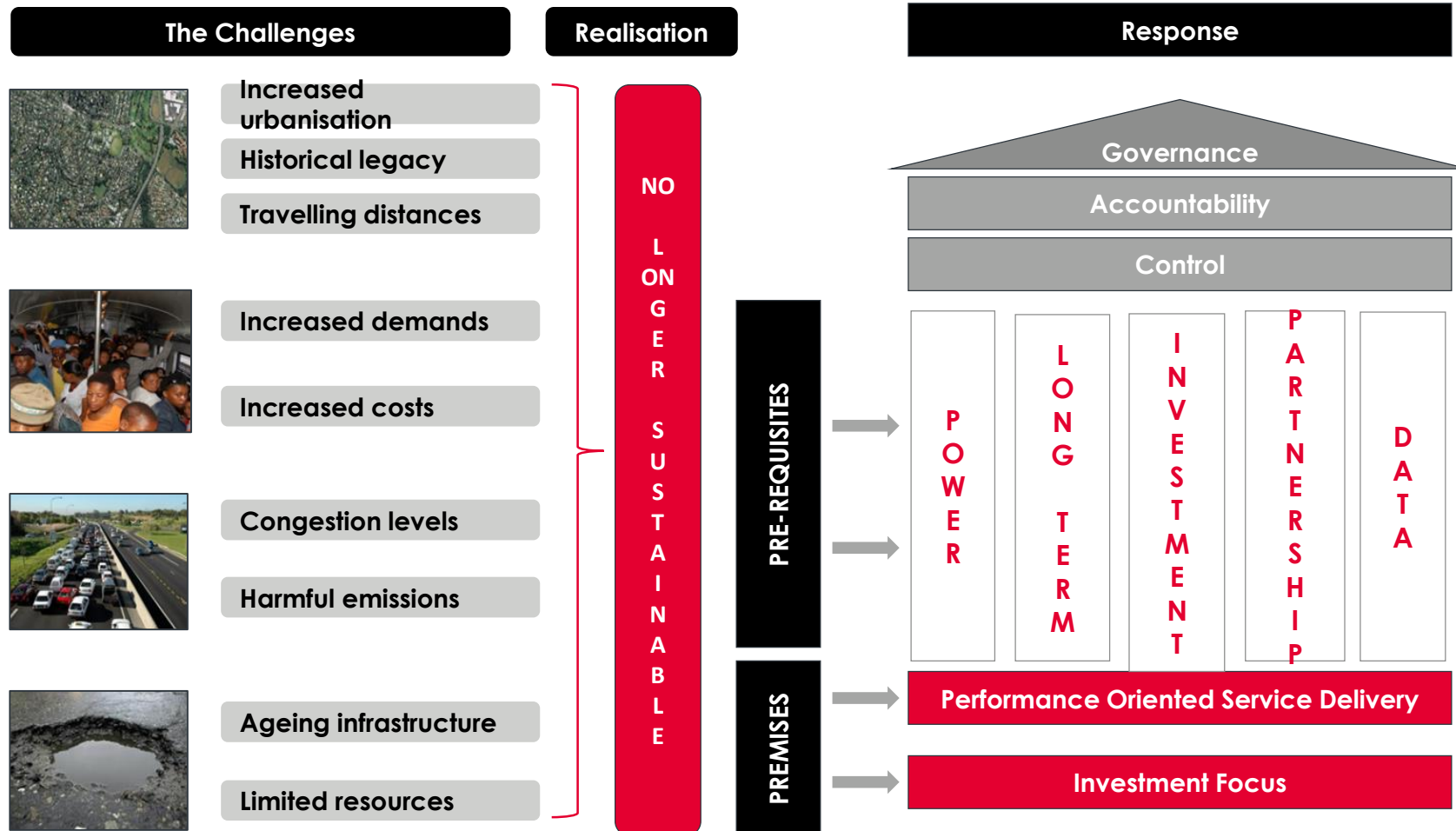
